She finds the bravery to reply by writing, and little by little, thanks to this new friendship, Carla starts to take small steps toward feeling comfortable again.

LA LEYENDA DE CANTUÑA

If you think that reading about history and culture is important, this book is for you!

This novella is based on Quito's most popular legend. It is a historical fiction novella that takes place in the 16th century during the Spanish conquest, when the Inca civilization came to an end, and the countries that we now know as Latin America became Spanish colonies.

SUMMARY: Cantuña, the main character, is a child of Inca descent who survives the Spanish conquest by luck. He has to adapt to a new reality in which living like a Spaniard is the safest bet for him. He dresses, talks, and lives like a Spaniard, but he looks indigenous. He's seen as an underdog by many, but his spirit of survival and his wits keep him alive.

This novella is written in the present tense and serves as an easy reader for mid-beginner and high-beginner students. While it is accessible for level one, it can also be effectively utilized at more advanced levels, including AP courses. The topics covered, such as Latin American history, colonialism, racism, diversity, Indigenous rights, and religion, encourage rich conversations.

Every chapter has a full glossary and an illustration. At the end of every chapter there is also a list of historical facts, for the reader to learn what parts of the story actually happened in reality. Depicting the historical events and accompanying the facts section there are drawings by Felipe Guamán Poma de Ayala, an indigenous chronicler who lived in the 16th and 17th centuries.

With about 170 unique words, 25 cognates, and plenty of repetition, the novella tells a 2,680-word story.

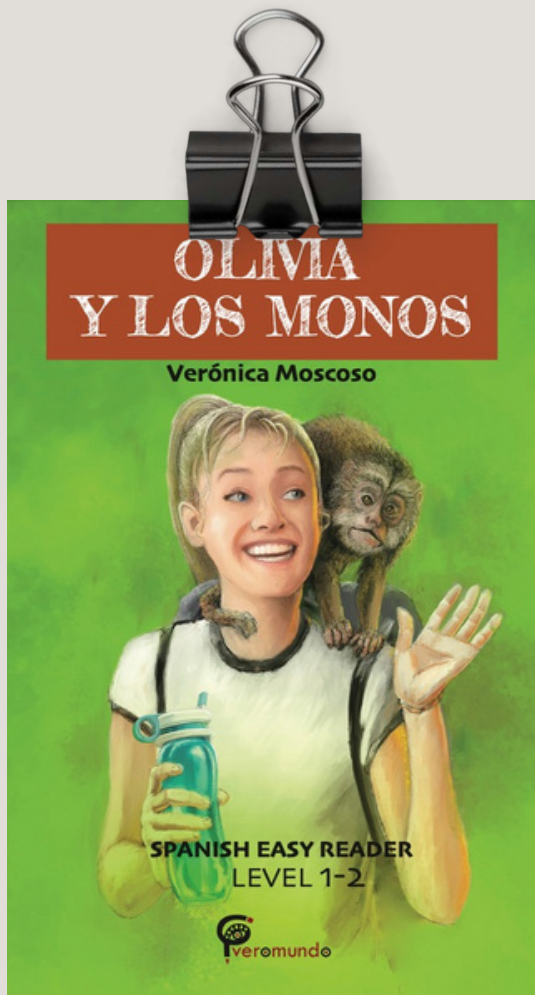

This novella is based on the true story of the Mishahuallí monkeys. Mishahuallí is a small village in the Ecuadorian Amazon where humans and monkeys share their home.

SUMMARY: Olivia is a very curious 16-year-old girl who likes to travel and who loves animals. She travels with her parents to Misahuallí. She is fascinated with the group of wild monkeys that live in the town. The monkeys approach and interact with tourists and the town's people.

In OLIVIA Y LOS MONOS one after another amusing situation occurs with the monkeys. The story is told from Olivia's point of view. Ecuadorian Verónica Moscoso, the author of this novella, visited Misahuallí to make a documentary. There she met the famous monkeys.

This book is based on events that she witnessed and filmed and on stories that the town's people told her.

OLIVIA Y LOS MONOS is an easy low-level Spanish novella for high beginners and low intermediate. It is almost entirely in the present tense with a smattering of past tense and no subjunctive. With about 270 unique words and plenty of repetition, it tells a 2,600-word story. A full glossary for each of the seven chapters is included plus illustrations for each chapter.

HALLOWEEN VS. DIA DE LOS MUERTOS

After experiencing the Day of the Dead in Mexico, Aleja, a Mexican American teen, returns to California inspired to host her own Día de los Muertos celebration. There's just one problem: her best friend's family has a long-standing tradition of throwing a big Halloween party on the same day.

Is this going to create tension between the two friends? Can their friendship survive this clash of traditions? And what kind of celebration will actually happen in the end?

Told in Aleja's voice, this light-hearted story is written almost entirely in the present tense.



It is a fun and accessible reader for high beginners and low-intermediate Spanish learners, making it a perfect fit for level two students just before Halloween and Día de los Muertos.

As students follow Aleja's story, they will not only build their Spanish skills through clear language and helpful repetition, but also explore two meaningful cultural traditions.

The book encourages readers to reflect on the differences and similarities between Halloween and Día de los Muertos. No wonder this book is especially popular in October!

With about 270 unique words and a total of 3,400 words, the story offers plenty of repetition, a glossary for each of the seven chapters, engaging illustrations, and real photos from the Day of the Dead celebration.

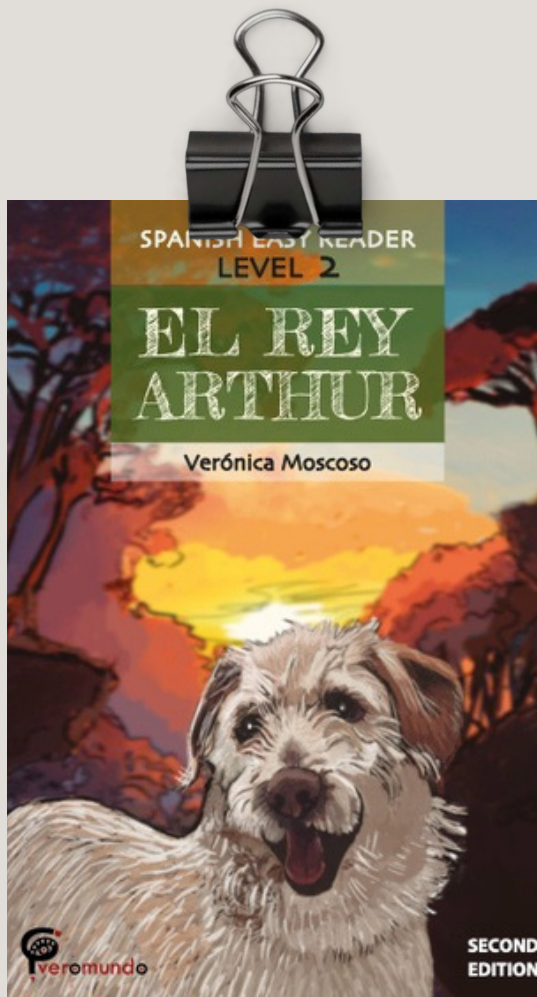

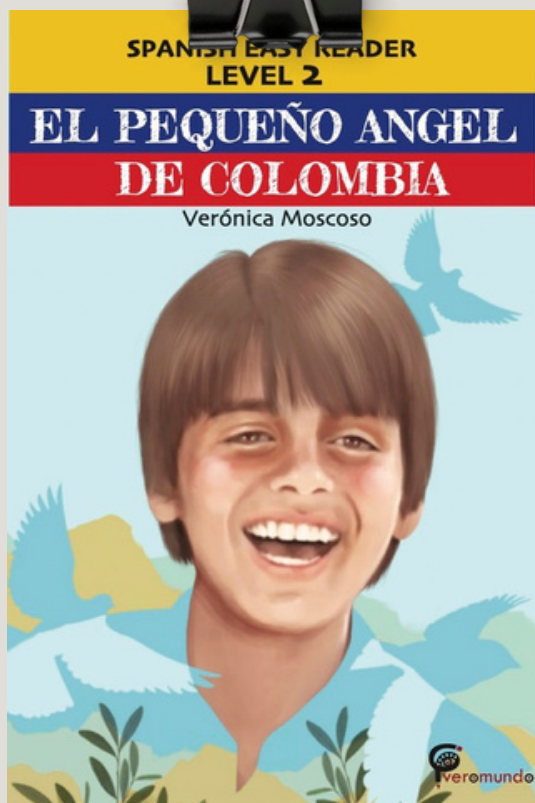

A full glossary for each of the nine chapters is included, and photos document this inspiring true story in each chapter.

ALMA DE LOBO

What happens when reality overcomes fiction? Then you have a story like ALMA DE LOBO. This novella is the true story of Marcos Rodríguez Pantoja. His is the only documented case in Spain of a feral child.

SUMMARY: At the age of seven, Marcos was sold by his father to work as a shepherd in a remote valley of the Sierra Morena. The older shepherd, who was teaching him the ropes, suddenly died, leaving Marcos on his own.

ALMA DE LOBO describes how Marcos manages to survive in the mountains after being adopted by a pack of wolves.

Then, the painful process of adapting to the world of humans after his capture, when he was 19-years-old. Hardly anyone believed his childhood stories, but when he was in his 60s an event changed his life...

ALMA DE LOBO is a page-turner. This novella is told in the past tense. It is an easy reader for intermediate and upper intermediate students - advanced second level students and third level students. With about 305 unique words and plenty of repetition, it tells a 4,190-word story. A full glossary for each of the ten chapters is included, plus illustrations for every chapter.

AUTHOR'S NOTE: This is one of the most fascinating stories I've ever researched and written about. I based this novella on the books, articles, interviews, movie and documentaries about Marcos' life. Most importantly, I was able to interview Marcos himself!!!

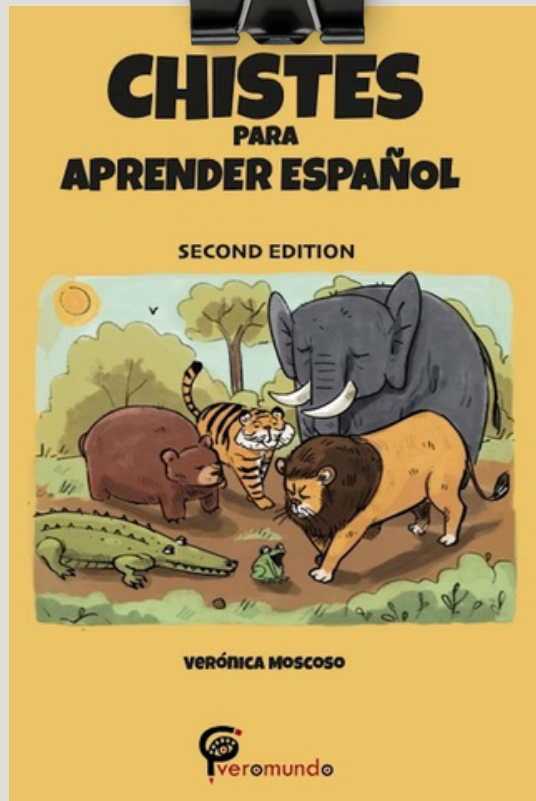

If you are looking for mini stories for Spanish acquisition, this book is for you. It has a compilation of 30 funny stories/jokes from different origins. These stories are written, almost totally, in present tense with simple vocabulary, simple grammatical forms, and plenty of repetition. Ideal for level 2 and up.

1. They are short easy-to-read jokes with no more than 100 to 150 total words each.
2. Every story is illustrated with a comical drawing that helps with comprehension.
3. Each joke is accompanied by a vocabulary list.
4. Every story also has a list of optional questions:

- **Preguntas de comprensión** - To check how well the student understood the text.
- **Usa tu imaginación** - For the students to create their own stories.
- **Preguntas sobre la historia and Preguntas personales** - For the students to express their opinion and use the context of the story to talk about themselves.

The questions serve as a helpful teacher's guide for every mini story/joke. Each story is a great opportunity for picture talk, reader's theater and more. This book is a great tool for engaging readers, utilizing both the power of storytelling and the joy of humor.

This book can be read just for the pleasure of reading it or to complement other ways of acquiring Spanish. It can be part of a course, or it can be something separate. Whether this book is used in this way or some other way, reading it will allow Spanish students to become more deeply familiar with many characteristics of Spanish and to do so without necessarily paying attention to vocabulary and grammatical usage.

Written as an easy Level 3 novella for Spanish learners, this book employs simple grammatical structures in various past tenses, along with some present subjunctive, touches of future and conditional, and plenty of repetition.

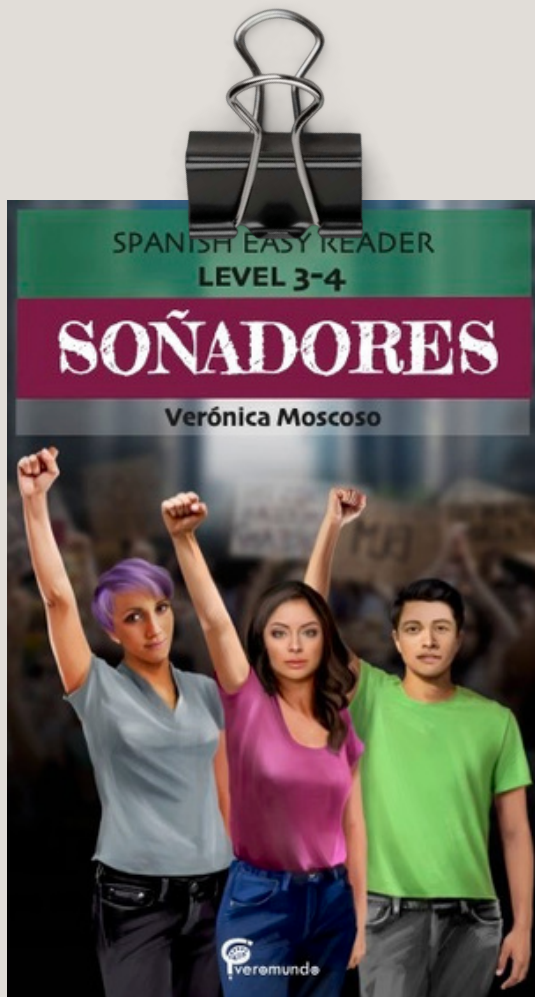

The author adeptly simplifies the complexities of immigration law, making it accessible to readers. Despite the characters' relentless struggles, the story is infused with humor and heartwarming moments.

SUMMARY: Sofía, Rosa, and Antonio are high school seniors who are very different from one another. But they form a special bond when they discover that all three are undocumented minors. Their friendship gets them through when their lives take unexpected turns. Together they accept who they are, join the DREAMers movement, and start fighting for their rights.

SOÑADORES is an easy reader novella for Spanish Learners. Third year and four year students will find it accessible and engaging. The story is written in conversational Spanish, using simple grammatical structures in various forms of the past, and plenty of repetition. With about 680 unique words, it tells a 8,300-word story. There is an illustration for every chapter and A full glossary is included at the end of the book.

AUTHOR'S NOTE: All the characters in SOÑADORES are fictional, but I used my real life experience and the experiences of my immigrant friends to write this novella. One of my goals is to use storytelling to humanize conversations about immigrants.
